

Sec 107-370 – Applicability.

This subdivision applies to property in the residential zoning district. (note: rest of sentence is deleted.)

Sec 107-371 – Definitions.

In this subdivision:

- (a) Protected species means: (no change)
- (b) Protected tree. Refer to Sec 107-3 Definitions.

- (d) Replacement tree means: (change “diameter “ to DBH)

 - (2) For the replacement tree species listed in subsection (c)(2), a tree with a DBH equal to not less than one-fourth the DBH of the protected tree it replaces up to a maximum DBH of five inches, which shall be maintained in a healthy condition after planting.
- (e) Heritage tree. Refer to Section 107-3.
- (f) Critical root zone. Refer to Section 107-3.
- (g) Removal means ...

 - (4) Construction impacts in violation of Section 101-256 which will require mitigation in accordance with the terms of this subdivision. However, flatwork, decking, or similar construction above ground and not disturbing roots is permitted within the CRZ, and such work shall be approved and shall not be classified as removal.

 - (5) Pruning not in accordance with ANSI A300 and as determined by the city arborist. Not more than twenty-five percent of the foliage shall be removed within an annual growing season.
