Discussion and possible action on authorizing the Mayor and staff to issue a Request for Proposal for cameras and technology infrastructure

Description:

A need has been identified for a camera system at each of the City's entry points. Camera system installation provides additional support to patrol officers, aiding in situational awareness and investigative support. Community input has emphasized a need for privacy protection, data ownership, and complete transparency, which should be accomplished by the restrictions placed upon the City's use of surveillance technologies in the previous agenda item. This also means that the system must operate as a closed-loop, city-owned solution with no cloud-based data storage or third-party data access.

Action Requested:

Discuss and potentially authorize the Mayor and staff to issue a Request for Proposals for cameras and technology infrastructure that comply with the City's regulations governing the acquisition and use of surveillance technology.

Fiscal Impacts:

The full fiscal impact of a surveillance system has yet to be determined. However, this item is expected to cost around \$200 in publication fees. The staff time necessary to prepare, issue, and review the RFP and its submittals is already included in the city's budget.
