Hi Alun,

Yes, I have photos from when I went out to inspect the leak. I took them on January 20, 2025, at 12:20 PM. The pictures show signs that the water line was struck by an object, possibly a metal stake, along the section that runs from the meter toward the house.

When I arrived, the meter box was completely submerged in water, and there was water flowing into the neighboring backyard and into the storm drain on the road, so there was definitely visible leakage.


Here's a summary of the data I collected for this location:

- Address: 104 Kristy Ln
- Constant water usage began: December 20, 2024, at approximately 10:15 AM
- Initial flow rate: 22 gallons per hour
- Flow increased daily, reaching 191 GPH on December 27
- Later that same day, usage spiked to 525 GPH
- By January 20, 2025, when I received the report, it had risen to 1,169 GPH

Based on the meter data, the leak had been active for about a month, from December 20, 2024, to January 20, 2025.

Daily usage (December 2024)




Daily usage (January 2025)


