(d) *Time of service.* Members of the reserve police force may be called into service whenever the police chief considers it necessary to have additional officers to preserve the peace and enforce the law, subject to ~~city council approval~~ by the mayor or the city administrator. Each member of the reserve police force shall not work more than twenty (20) hours per week, if called into service.

(e) *Appearance as witnesses; witness fees.* Members of the reserve police force shall appear as witnesses whenever necessary in a prosecution for a violation of an ordinance or of any state or federal law. Members shall not retain witness fees in any action or suit to which the city is a party. Any fees paid for such services shall be submitted to the police chief, who shall deposit the same with the city treasurer.

(f) *Compensation of members; benefits.* Members of the reserve police force shall ~~receive~~ serve without compensation for their work at an hourly rate as fixed by the mayor, with such rate not to exceed the base hourly rate of pay for members of the regular police force as fixed by the city council under Section 14-21(e) of this Article. Members of the reserve police force may be provided hospital and medical assistance for injuries sustained in the course of performing official duties in the same manner provided for full-time police officers.

**SECTION 3.** All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rollingwood in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rollingwood not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** Should any sentence, paragraph, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
