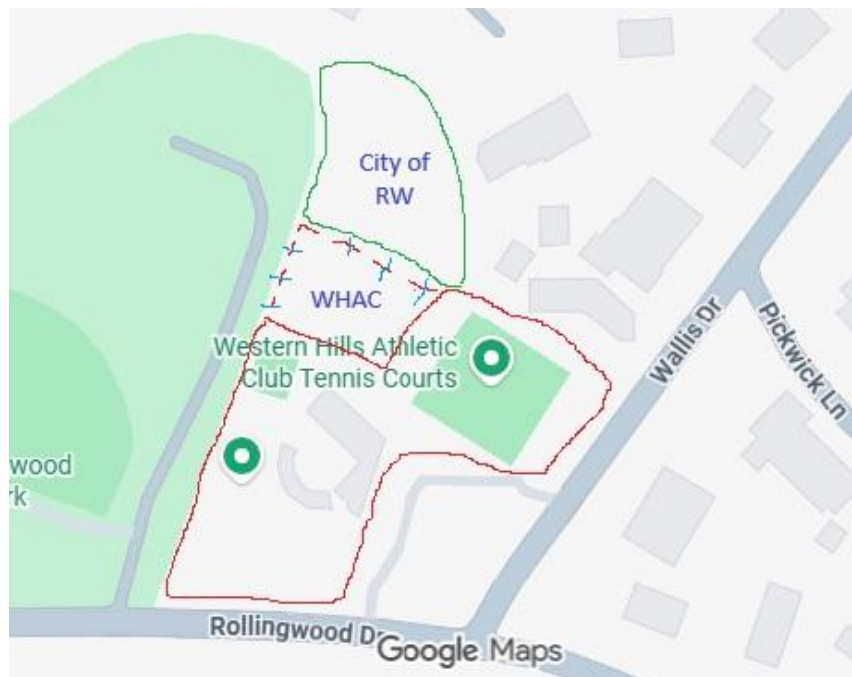
Agenda Item:

Update regarding the Boy Scout Troop service project to clean up the wilderness area in the northeast corner of the upper park

Description:

During its December 17, 2025 meeting, Council approved a project by Boy Scout Troop 31 to clean-up the natural area in the northeast corner of the upper park, shown surrounded by a green line in the map below. The boy scouts noted that the area contained a lot of dead organic material, including a lot of large fallen tree limbs, and the unsafe remnants of a “fort” that appeared to have been built by children.

Public Works Director Izzy Parra met with Steve Marcie onsite and agreed to the proposed scope of work. The Boy Scouts, which included Troops 25, 72, and 550 due to the scope of work, worked on the project on a weekend and stacked the brush at a designated location in the upper park. Then, during the work week, the Public Works crew disposed of the debris in a roll-off dumpster.
