Discussion and possible action regarding the regulation, permitting, and adoption of fees for commercial motion picture and television productions

Description:

The City of Rollingwood's current code does not address commercial motion pictures and television productions. Due to the City's scenic character and proximity to a major metropolitan area, Rollingwood is an attractive location for commercial filming activities. Without appropriate regulations, such activities may cause disruptions that negatively affect residents, visitors, traffic flow, public safety, and the overall quality of life in the community.

To protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public, staff recommends the adoption of reasonable regulations governing commercial motion picture and television productions within the City. The proposed ordinance would establish permitting requirements and operational standards for filming activities, while the accompanying resolution would amend the City's fee schedule to establish fees associated with the permitting process.

Action Requested:

Discuss and consider approval of an ordinance establishing regulations and permitting requirements for commercial motion picture and television productions within the City of Rollingwood, and approval of a resolution amending the City's fee schedule to establish related permit fees.

Fiscal Impacts:
