My son, Noah, has played baseball on Hatley Field 3 with his team, and it's really upsetting to deal with the constant presence of dog waste scattered across the field. This not only creates an unsanitary situation but also poses potential health risks to the children and diminishes the overall experience for everyone involved.

To address this ongoing problem, I suggest exploring the creation of a compact, dedicated dog park—kept to 0.4 acres or smaller—to provide a designated spot for dogs while ensuring our community fields remain clean and suitable for youth sports.
