LNV also provided the City with prioritization of cul-de-sac waterline projects and provided K Friese with information for inclusion with the Rollingwood Infrastructure Improvement Plan.

3. Water Distribution System Support

LNv continues to provide support on an as needed basis. LNV is currently working with AWR to aid as needed for obtaining proposal for water system leak detection. No changes are necessary to the December 2018 Water System Map. LNV will continue to support Jackie Bob with waterline abandonment and updating of the water system map.
