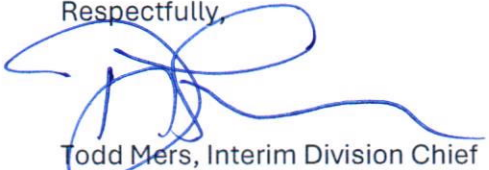
Dear Mr. Thomas,
