Agenda Item:

Discussion and possible action on a recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission and set a public hearing date on a proposed ordinance amending Ch. 107, Section 107-3 of the Rollingwood Code of Ordinances related to playhouses and playscapes

Description:

At the **May 20, 2026, Planning and Zoning Commission meeting**, Commissioners discussed proposed language that amends the current definition of *Accessory building or structure* and adds a definition for *Exempt children's playhouse and Playscape*.

Commissioner Jay van Bavel moved to approve the amended Section 107-3 definition of accessory building or structure as presented, with the following modifications to the exempt children's playhouse definition: maximum area of 100 square feet, maximum height of 10 feet, and a minimum setback of 8 feet from the lot line. The motion was seconded by Patricia Barnes. The motion carried with 4 in favor and 1 opposed (Fleming).

At the **July 1, 2026, Planning and Zoning Commission meeting**, Commissioners discussed the drafted ordinance regarding playhouses and playscapes.

Dave Bench moved to send the proposed ordinance to City Council to set a public hearing. Jay van Bavel seconded the motion. The motion carried with 4 in favor and 0 opposed.

Action Requested:

Discuss and accept the recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission to set a public hearing date on a proposed ordinance amending Ch. 107, Section 107-3 of the Rollingwood Code of Ordinances related to playhouses and playscapes
