

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-\_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES ARTICLE IV-BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS BY ADDING SECTION 2-193 - MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rollingwood is a General Law Type A City under the statutes of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Rollingwood (“City Council”) wishes to establish certain uniform qualifications for all city council appointed boards, commissions and committees; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that, to provide for a pool of qualified candidates for public service, the public is served by adopting, for boards and commissions, the same qualifications as applied to individuals who wish to serve on the city council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the amendments provided for herein are reasonable, necessary, and proper for the good of the City.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** All the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

**SECTION 2.** The City’s Code of Ordinances, Section 2-193- Membership requirements, be adopted to read as follows:

The qualifications to serve on City Council-appointed boards, commissions, and committees shall be the same qualifications as applied to candidates for the position of alderman in the City.

**SECTION 3.** All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rollingwood in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rollingwood not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** Should any sentence, paragraph, sub Article, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so Ordinance — Membership Requirements decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
