16 17	WHEREAS , the City Council finds that the establishment of a Commercial Lighting and Signage Manual will serve a public purpose by allowing for a more efficient government.

	SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.
	SECTION 5. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to the other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be invalid, and the City





The following exhibits illustrate examples of a shielded light fixtures, conforming and nonconforming light fixtures as described in Code of Ordinances Chapter 107, Article II, Division 1, Sec.107-39(a)(i), definition of "Shielded":

In Exhibit "B" (below), the lights on the left are nonconforming. Those on the right can be used in most cases. However, the mounting height and proximity to the property line may cause them to need additional shielding to prevent the luminous elements from being visible from any other property.
