Presentation and discussion regarding the MoPac South Expansion Project

**Description:**

The MoPac South Expansion Project continues to make progress, and Mayor Massingill and staff continue to monitor and engage in the process. On February 27, 2026, Mayor Massingill and City Administrator Thomas met with the City of West Lake Hills, CTRMA, and the MoPac South Project Team to discuss the proposed Bee Cave Road intersection improvements, including an evaluation of a proposed Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). CTRMA stressed that the DDI is not currently funded and remains an alternative concept under evaluation, not part of the base schematic, but eligible for inclusion pending public support and environmental clearance (FONSI). Preliminary estimates suggest the intersection improvement could cost under \$5 million, with further analysis underway.

CTRMA indicated the DDI could significantly improve traffic flow, potentially reducing delays by up to 50%, though detailed morning and afternoon peak analyses are pending. Both cities raised concerns regarding neighborhood impacts, including traffic near local schools, noise abatement feasibility, and aesthetic considerations. Noise barriers have been included in the project, but the installation of such barriers will depend on feasibility, benefit thresholds, and a property owner voting process.
