Overview/Background Information

This fencing is for two locations at Public Works. The first part is behind the public works salt shed and between the new addition building and salt shed. The other location is in the Police impound area. Staff has received three quotes from fencing companies. They ranged from \$27,634, \$19,412, and the winning quote from Crimson Valley Landscaping/Estate Deck & Fence for \$15,000.

For the area behind the salt shed, the new chain-link fencing will extend (90') from the salt shed all the way down the Villages property line. The chain-link now stops at the start of the salt shed. This extra fencing will define the Villages property line and help with security of the equipment. This also will include two gates, one at the end of the salt shed and the other between the new addition building and the salt shed. This will keep anyone from going behind the new addition and give us some more security to lock up equipment.

For the area in the Police impound, the new chain-link fencing will extend (75') from the front (parking lot side) to the rear. There will also be a new gate put in the front. This will split the Police impound and the new Public Works side and allow Public Works to be able to access our generator or store some equipment and not have to have the Police escort to go into the impound.

Key Issues

- More security for the building and equipment
- More secured storage space
- No more needing the Police to escort us in the impound

Fiscal Note/Budget Impact

This project was budgeted for the 2024 year with \$24,000

Prior Legislative Actions

This is project was approved at the Committee of the Whole on 11/05/2024.

Action Required/Recommendation

Staff recommends the approval of Crimson Valley Landscaping/Estate Deck & Fence for the fence installation at Public Works for the quoted amount of \$15,000.
