Bites and Beats Food Truck Event

Beginning in April 2027, Roscoe Township will be hosting a recurring **Bites and Beats Food Truck Event** on the first Friday of select months, with the first event proposed for April 2, 2027.

The event would feature food trucks in the separate parking area near the Quonset hut, which would be blocked off from other vehicle traffic. Entertainment would take place inside the Roscoe Community Center, while the pavilion would primarily be used for outdoor dining. Occasional entertainment may also be held under the pavilion when weather permits, provided the entertainer does not require amplified sound.

Police Chief Hawley, Deputy Chief Farone, Fire Chief Bergeron, Interim Administrator Wrighton, Township Supervisor Nowicki, Activities Coordinator Hannah Breault, and I met on site to review the proposed event layout and operations.

Because the event will not take place on Village property, Village Board approval is not required. The Interim Administrator has the authority to approve the Special Event Permit. Staff would like to use the April 2, May 7, and June 4 events as an opportunity to ensure the event operates smoothly and to identify any concerns that may need to be addressed before the event series continues. Accordingly, the Special Event Permit has been approved contingent upon these initial events operating successfully and without significant issues.
