Overview/Background Information

This agenda request is for the purchase of two Kubota ZD1611 72" zero turn mowers for \$39,847.44. This quote is from Bobcat of Rockford with a Sourcewell government discount of \$6,137.78, plus a trade in of the older 72" Kubota zero turn for \$5,000. These two mowers will replace our older 72" and 60" zero turn mowers. These new mowers have more power and fuel capacity to help with getting more acreage mowed.

These two mowers have already been approved once by the Village Board, but there was an error on the quote that staff found. Bobcat had marked downed \$10,000 for trade in instead of the \$5,000, so the total price should be \$39,847.44 instead of the \$34,847.44 that was approved at the last Village Board meeting on 04/15/2025. This Total price is still under the budgeted amount for these mowers.

Key Issues

- Villages older mowers now are starting to break down more often.
- New mowers will be able to cut more, be under warranty, and have less break downs.

Fiscal Note/Budget Impact

These two mowers were budgeted for the 2025 year at \$45,000. We will be under budget by Kubota holding their quoted price from late-2024 and still be able to order extra parts such as front tires, back tires, mowing blades, and all the different type of filters for the first service.

Prior Legislative Actions

These mowers have already been approved by the previous Committee of The Whole and Village Board.

Action Required/Recommendation

Staff is recommending Bobcat of Rockford for the quoted amount of \$39,847.44 for the purchase of two Kubota ZD1611 72" zero turn mower.
