Over the past 7 years living in Boise, I've become a good friend with a man who happens to be the sustainability specialist for Boise's department of parks and recreation. Danny has shared with me his triumphs and challenges working with Boise's Community Forestry Program and their City of Trees Challenge. Housed under the City's department of parks and rec while partnering with the University of Idaho Extension Office, they've created an extensive urban forestry team facilitating volunteerism, public education, planting, maintenance, and removal of trees while identifying violations, and selling both wood and mulch. I'm excited to see how these ideas might be scaled down from a city of 200,000 to my new city of 5000 residents. He's also shared his experience with applying for and winning a share of the USDA's Urban and Community Forestry grants that are part of the Inflation Reduction Act.
