F Street Community Stage.

BACKGROUND

A group of performing artists have requested a stage to be located in the F St. closure between 2nd and 3rd in the street in front of Natural Grocers. Local performers and artists would use the stage. Several local groups have written letters of support for the stage, and they, as well as others would like to perform on it during the summer. Businesses in the area have signed a petition of support for the project. There will be no cost for performing to the groups for using the stage.

The stage will consist of an outdoor weather resistant stage 16' by 20' designed to work in the space requested.

The stage usage will be managed by a committee of those groups using the stage. The City Arts and Culture department will provide assistance as needed.

Attached is the request to City Council from the artists involved.

The funding of \$25,000 for the stage is available in the Public Art Commissions approved 2022 budget.
