The City of Salida will host Salida Bike Fest this September 18 -20.. Events that will specifically take place in the city of Salida are, kids bike decorating in Alpine park on saturday morning in cooperation with the Farmers market followed by a bike parade through town led by Salida Police.

The Salida Bike Festival is a 3 day festival celebrating bicycles of all kinds. Various groups in Salida have teamed up to create and promote unique and fun bike events throughout the week. These events include the Annual Monarch Crest Crank; the Banana Belt Mountain Bike Race, and kids bike decorating in Alpine park.
