Council Action: Approve Letter of support for Salida Mountain Trails grant application

BACKGROUND

Salida Mountain Trails (SMT) is a local non-profit whose is "committed to building and maintaining sustainable, non-motorized, multi-use trails on public lands adjoining the city of Salida". SMT is applying for a grant from the American Trails organization to upgrade the trail to the Loyal Duke memorial. The grant requires a letter of support from the landowner that the trail is on.l

FISCAL NOTE

The grant requires a 20% match and has a maximum amount of \$15,000. SMT would use \$3,000 from their already allocated \$10,00 from Conservation Trust Funds minus any applicable in-kind donations of staff time, tools, or work from city staff.
