SUBJECT: Extraordinary Teen Council – School Resource Officer Survey and

Student Liaison Guidelines

Background

As noted in a prior City Council worksession, the Extraordinary Teen Council (ETC) would like to establish a liaison between the Council and students in Salida Public Schools. The ETC has prepared a survey (attached) with regard to the School Resource Officer position. The current ETC liaison is Jessie Rollins, who will make a presentation to the City Council at the June 14th worksession.

Analysis

Providing empirical data to the City Council on the opinions of the student body gives staff and the City Council additional perspectives on the success of our SRO program (as well as other potential topics in the future). In addition, a regular liaison presentation to the City Council – currently proposed as quarterly – is a great opportunity to interact with, and learn from, the future citizens and voters in Salida.

The liaison position is proposed to be structured as follows:

Salida City Council Student Liaison Position Guidelines

Current Liaison: Jessie Rollins, SHS student and ETC member

- Attend Council Work sessions quarterly-March, June, September, December
- Standing agenda topics:
 - Address ongoing discussion topics and city council concerns
 - Successes and challenges related to teen mental health
 - Addressing teen needs/interests/concerns (Jessie to gather through teen councils and insta poll).
 - Access to prosocial activities (ie-fibark, how can city council support teen involvement)
 - Jessie run agenda by Justin and Dibby. Once oked, send to City Council ahead of mtg.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council provide feedback on this approach to establishing lines of communication with students in our community.
