

## **CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION**

**MEETING DATE:** August 31, 2020

**AGENDA ITEM:** 2021 Revenue Projections

Predicting revenues is a crucial part of the budget process. Revenues should be determined initially before forward progress is made determining spending plans. Revenues should be budgeted conservatively so that there is less danger of overcommitting limited resources.

There is much uncertainty right now but so far, Salida is weathering the COVID-19 storm fairly well with revenue streams only expected to decline 4.4% as compared to budget this year (we feel this is a conservative estimate).

An August 13 article in the Denver post reporting on Colorado retail sales data stated that for every city or town in the state that had a decline in retail sales, another two showed gains. A recent CML survey confirmed varying results among municipalities in Colorado (that survey follows).

The below shows what is in the proposed budget for Salida's Governmental Funds (all funds with the exception of Utilities). One time revenues (i.e. grants) skew the analysis and were removed from this:
