# Chairman Keith Krebs recused himself from the Public Hearing

2. Cowen Farms- 701 E. Highway 50 - Major Certificate of Approval

The Southwest Conservation Corps is requesting to receive approval for the demolition of the historic barn at The Cowen Farms local landmark located at 701 E. Highway 50.

**Staff Review of Application** - Jefferson gave an overview of the application and stated that staff recommends approval of the application with the following conditions:

- 1. That the applicant salvage as much of the materials as possible from the demolition of the barn to be used in the proposed new building.
- 2. That the applicant submit a certificate of approval application for the construction of the new building that will replace the historic barn.

**Applicants Presentation:** The applicant's representative Anna Hendricks explained the need for demolition of the barn. Keith Krebs, explained the history of the project and suggested that the applicant provide a plaque giving the history of the Cowen property.

**Commission Discussion:** Harris opened the Commission discussion:

- There was discussion about the engineer's report that was submitted with the application.
- The location of the barn was discussed and since the barn is not highly visible demolition should not be detrimental to the property.

**Decision:** Co-Chairman Harris made a motion to approve the application with the two conditions recommended by staff and added a third condition:

- 1. That the applicant salvage as much of the materials as possible from the demolition of the barn to be used in the proposed new building.
- 2. That the applicant submit a certificate of approval application for the construction of the new building that will replace the historic barn.
- 3. That the applicant apply for a demolition permit as required by the Chaffee County Building Department.
