



RESOLUTION NO. 2024-26

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXCEPTION TO THE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNING AUTHORITY TO ADMINISTER SANDY CLEAN WATERS AND DRINKING WATER SYSTEM REINVESTMENT ON-CALL CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy is committed to the successful completion of the Sandy Clean Waters Program and the Drinking Water System Reinvestment Program; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2017-28 establishes the parameters of the of the City Manager's signing authority for construction related services for contracts legally required to be provided by an engineer; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to complete projects for the Sandy Clean Waters Program in a timely and expeditious manner, pursuant to the Consent Decree executed with the Environmental Protection Agency and the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality; and

WHEREAS, it is also in the public interest to complete projects for the Drinking Water System Reinvestment Program in a timely and expeditious manner, consistent with the bilateral compliance agreement with the Oregon Health Authority related to cryptosporidium; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2024 the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute on-call construction contracts with James W. Fowler Co. and R.L. Reimers Company for a maximum total fee of \$10,000,000 (\$5,000,000 per construction firm); and

WHEREAS, the drinking water and wastewater facility minor upgrades required for these programs were previously approved as part of the BN 2023-25 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY:

Section 1: The signing authority of the City Manager pursuant to Resolution No. 2017-28 is temporarily expanded to include Sandy Clean Waters Program and Drinking Water System Reinvestment Program On-Call Construction task orders, not to exceed a maximum fee of \$10,000,000 (\$5,000,000 per construction firm) as stipulated in each contract.

Section 2: This exception to the City Manager's signing authority shall remain in effect through September 30, 2027.

Section 3: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

This resolution is adopted by the City Council of the City of Sandy this 2nd day of December, 2024.
