



A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXCEPTION TO THE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNING AUTHORITY TO ADMINISTER THE SANDY CLEAN WATERS ON CALL ENGINEERING CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy is committed to the successful completion of the Sandy Clean Waters Program; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2017-28 establishes the parameters of the of the City Manager's signing authority for construction related services for contracts legally required to be provided by an engineer; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to complete projects for the Sandy Clean Waters Program in a timely and expeditious manner, pursuant to the Consent Decree executed with the Environmental Protection Agency and the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater facility minor upgrades required for the Sandy Clean Waters program wastewater treatment plant improvements were previously approved as part of the BN 2023-25 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY:

Section 1: The signing authority of the City Manager pursuant to Resolution No. 2017-28 is temporarily expanded to include Sandy Clean Waters Program On-Call Engineering task orders not to exceed \$500,000 per task order and not to exceed \$1,000,000 cumulative for all task orders per contract.

Section 2: This exception to the City Manager's signing authority shall be in effect for the next three years, through December 17, 2026.

Section 3: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

This resolution is adopted by the City Council of the City of Sandy this 18th day of December, 2023.
