We are excited to provide this bid package to you and look forward to working together on your Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Inspection Services Project. We have reviewed the draft contract and have no potential areas for negotiation. Pricing and proposal is valid for 90 days. Below we have provided some basic information and background on our company followed by the bid submittal package.

SUMMARY: Olson Brothers Pro-Vac, LLC began operations in 1995 with a small fleet of vac & CCTV trucks, providing construction related vacuum services. By providing a high level of quality, the firm has maintained continued growth, adding to the fleet each year, and adding additional divisions. In 2016, Pro-Vac took on an equity partner, forming Olson Brother's Pro-Vac, LLC. This provided the opportunity for expansion, and we added 15% to the fleet. In 2017, we completed the purchase of Everson's Econo-Vac, which added 30% capacity to the fleet, and several experienced employees to our staff. In 2020, we then added Best Parking Lot to our fleet to expand our operations even further. Most recently, in 2022, we have acquired and merged with Vac-One Services and expanded our services to include a total of 16 states.

Olson Brother's Pro-Vac, LLC has the Northwest's largest fleet of vacuum trucks and trained operators. Currently, we have over 120 Vac Trucks, 8 CCTV trucks, 21 Sweepers, Water Trucks, Pump Trucks, Grout Trucks, and over 200 operators & laborers.

We operate 24 hours a day through our staffed dispatch group, to ensure we are available to respond immediately to any requests for service. We have a staff of six salespersons and several project managers throughout the Puget Sound area for rapid response to any job issue and to ensure that all jobs will have onsite manager supervision, quality review and approvals before a job is complete. We are able to route our trucks in an efficient manner utilizing GPS tracking.

We take maintenance of our fleet very seriously. We have onsite a three-bay maintenance garage for our vac trucks, staffed around the clock, with four mechanics working exclusively on preventative maintenance, and two additional mechanics available for major rebuilds. Additionally, we have a network of trusted third-party vendors we can use for overflow work.

The scope of work as outlined is very similar to current contracts we have in place. We will train specific crews on the required methodologies and do our best to ensure that your work orders and contracts retain the same trained crew. Our goal is to make sure our operators are aware of the specifics of this project, including access to the worksite, communication with your staff, etc.

We make every effort to be environmentally conscious on jobs. Vehicles are inspected daily to prevent leaks of fluids. We have a dedicated spill response project manager available to respond to any waste product we encounter. Additionally, we have profiles on each waste product we are cleaning or transporting.

We make a significant effort to ensure equal employment opportunities at Pro-Vac, directly from the hiring/recruiting process. Hiring managers are trained in interview skills to avoid any direct questions (or the appearance of) that would indicate any bias. We look forward to collaborating with you. Bid Proposal

Having carefully examined the Agreement titled, City of Sandy CCTV Inspection Services, the Contractor agrees to furnish all the labor, materials, equipment, superintendence, and insurance, as well as other accessories and services, necessary to perform and complete all of the work required by and in strict accordance with this Agreement and the implied intent thereof, for the following schedule of unit prices:

Bidders are to provide lineal foot and per each cost for each of the respective pipe size ranges. Based on the lineal foot or per each price, Bidders are then to project total price for each of the respective pipe size ranges. The TOTAL BID Cost will be the sum of each of the respective pipe size range cost. The ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED will be 33.3% of the TOTAL BID COST.

The City's desire is to perform CCTV inspection of 33.3% of each utility annually. The annual NOT TO EXCEED COST is the estimated annual contract value for conducting work on the planned 33.3% of the system. These lineal quantities are estimated total quantities at the time of publication and will change during the life of the contract. Actual annual inspected lineal quantities and respective pipe sizes for each utility will vary based on the needs of the City and available funding.


