**AGENDA ITEM:** Hail Damage Repairs – September 21, 2025 Storm Event -Consideration and

possible action on approving the payment for hail damage repairs.

## **SUMMARY:**

 On September 21, 2025, a severe hailstorm impacted the City of Sanger, resulting in damage to multiple City vehicles across several departments. Following the event, the city filed a claim with the Texas Municipal League (TML) Intergovernmental Risk Pool for assessment and repair cost estimation.

- TML has completed its evaluation and provided an estimated repair cost totaling \$83,969.86 for 15 vehicles affected by the storm. This amount reflects the necessary bodywork, glass replacement, and related repairs to restore the vehicles to operational condition.
- The city will be utilizing Dent Source as the vendor to complete the hail damage repairs. Dent Source was selected based on their experience with municipal fleet repairs and coordination with TML claims. The city will proceed with the necessary repairs to ensure that all vehicles remain safe, functional, and available for continued service to the community.
- Municipalities new threshold to bid is \$100,000, so no bid waiver is required.
