RECOMMENDATION: Approve and sign letter

SUMMARY

Lisbon Valley Mine's Proposed Plan of Operations includes expanding its area of operations. This expansion may necessitate closure of certain county roads or segments of roads during mining operations. Such closures may not be acceptable as County policy supports public and other authorized access on all roads in the County Travel Plan. The County has worked with Utah's Public Lands Policy Coordinating Office (PLPCO) on language to be included in the Mine's Proposed Plan of Operations that would protect and maintain such access including the establishment of re-routes for blocked County roads. The attached letter asks that BLM require that this County Road language be included in the mine's Proposed Plan of Operations.

HISTORY/PAST ACTION

PLPCO has made a similar request for addition of road language to the Proposed Plan of Operations.
