Re: Lisbon Valley Mine Proposed Plan of Operations

Dear Mr. Pals:

We are concerned about potential impacts to public access on county roads if proposed mining operations by the Lisbon Valley Mine need to close roads or segments of roads to public and other authorized access during mining operations. We believe that public access must be maintained on roads in the County Travel Plan. If public access must be blocked on county roads due to mining operations, a suitable reroute of the blocked road segment must be constructed.

We have worked with Utah's Public Lands Policy Coordinating Office (PLPCO) in developing the attached wording for this issue applying to both RS2477 claimed roads as well as other roads in the County Transportation System (Travel Plan). We ask that this wording be incorporated into the mine's Proposed Plan of Operations.

Thank you for your consideration and we look forward to working with you on this issue.
