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### SUMMARY

This is an amendment to an existing contract.

The general purpose of this contract is to address physical activity, nutrition, obesity, diabetes and heart disease in San Juan County.

**PURPOSE OF CONTRACT AMENDMENT:** To add funding for FY21, update funding dates for FY21, adjust coding, and update contract activities in special provisions.

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO CONTRACT:** Update activities for PBG, 1807 and 1817 federal grants. Adding funding of \$17,764.14 to PBG federal grant for FY21. Adding funding of \$9,174.12 to 1807 federal grant for FY21. Adding funding of \$27,200.00 to 1817 federal grant for FY21. New total contract amount is \$186,894.78.

We have received EPICC funding since 2015. This contract has been renewed annually since 2015.
