that Letters of Interest are being accepted for vacancies or expired terms on the following voluntary Boards and Committees, reappointments of expiring members may be considered as a higher priority for vacancies:

**Planning Commission:** One (1) at-large position for a four-year term, specifically representing the Bluff area of the County.

Travel expenses will be reimbursed for meeting attendance. Applicants must be residents and registered voters of San Juan County.

Preferred qualifications include experience or knowledge in land use; familiarity with County and local issues; strong listening and communication skills; and analytical reasoning abilities.

Preferred qualifications may be waived in the event of limited qualified applicants.

Written statements of interest and qualifications must be submitted in accordance with the required publication period and will be accepted until **Friday, March 20**, which is not less than fifteen (15) days from the date of publication of this notice.

**San Juan Noxious Weed Control Board:** 2 members for four-year terms. The Noxious Weed Board makes recommendations to the Commission and staff for overall weed control policy to ensure compliance with the Utah Noxious Weed Act. Members shall be farmers or ranchers whose primary source of income is derived from agriculture production.

The Board of San Juan County Commissioners will make final appointments at one of its upcoming regular meetings. Interested parties are encouraged to submit their current resume along with a letter of interest and for which Board you are interested in volunteering for.
