Irrigation Evaluation/Plans

USU Extension and irrigation dealers or your choosing will conduct irrigation evaluations and help participants develop a 5-year IMP (irrigation management plan).



Irrigation Support

Participants will receive equipment and training on a soil moisture sensing station, automated weather station, and flow meter to assist in water management. These are valued at over \$9,000 per farm.



Alternative Crop Seed

Participants will receive up to \$200 per acre for a total of 10 acres in seed costs for new crops with lower water use.



Compensation for Reporting

Participants who report on their IMP progress and share water use data will receive an annual \$750 credit at irrigation dealer of their choosing.

Requirements

Participation is voluntary and will not obligate participants to participate in any other water management program. Participants need to farm/ranch within the Jordan, Sevier, Utah Lake, or Uintah Basins or in the greater Colorado River Basin. Participants will make a 5-year commitment to develop and report progress on a farm or company IMP and collaborate with USU.
