## Attachment A: Scope of Work San Juan County Health Department - Preventative Health and Health Services Block Grant 2025

## Article 1 SUBRECIPIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

2.1	Subrecipient	Responsibilities.	The Subreci	niant chall.
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- (1) expand prevention in two or more of the following objectives;
  - (A) neighborhood and built environment;
  - (B) social and community context;
  - (C) economic stability;
  - (D) education access and quality; and
  - (E) healthcare access and quality;
- (2) implement a minimum of six activities from the 'OBJECTIVES LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT (LHD) ANNUAL ACTIVITIES' section of the <u>Preventative Health and Health Services Block Grant FY25 workplan</u>;
- (3) document in the designated reporting system a written progress narrative quarterly for each activity that funds were allocated towards by the 15th of January, April, July and October;
- (4) document one success story or innovative approach in the designated reporting system by October of each year; and
- (5) attend 75% of technical assistance webinars and meetings.

### Article 2 FUNDING

#### 2.1 Funding.

- (1) \$38,436.00 for the period October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026.
- 2.2 This is a cost reimbursement agreement . DHHS agrees to reimburse the Subrecipient up to the maximum amount of the agreement for expenditures made by the Subrecipient directly related to the performance of this agreement.

- 2.3 **Unallowable costs**. The Subrecipient shall: not use funding for:
  - (1) purchasing naloxone;
  - (2) purchasing syringes;
  - (3) drug disposal programs;
  - (4) clinical care (except as allowed by law); and
  - (5) publicity and propaganda (lobbying).

### Article 3

3.1 The Subrecipient shall report monthly expenditures on the Monthly Expenditure Report submitted to DHHS.

### Article 4 OUTCOMES

- 4.1 **Outcomes**. The Subrecipient shall contribute to the following outcomes and report to DHHS the following measures:
  - (1) DHHS will know the impact that implemented activities have on the drivers of health in the community:
    - (A) Measure: objectives and activities being implemented that impact the data-informed drivers of health at the community level;
    - (B) Measure: percent of schools with an active, comprehensive health and wellness strategy;
    - (C) Measure: percent increase in Positive Childhood Experience activities implemented;
    - (D) Measure: percent increase in the number of diabetes and cardiovascular health programs implemented in the community;
    - (E) Measure: number of policies written or recommendations made related to increasing healthy food access; and

- (F) Measure: percent of population reached through activities focused on local health priorities.
- Reporting requirements. Through the duration of the project, the Subrecipient shall submit quarterly progress reports and a final progress report no later than October 15th of each State fiscal year in a format approved of by the DHHS designee and demonstrates work completed and progress made.
