# Home Energy Assistance Target (HEAT) Program

The HEAT Program provides year-round energy assistance for eligible low-income households throughout Utah.

You may qualify for the HEAT program one time per year. The program year begins October 1st and ends the following September 30th of each year or when federal LIHEAP funds are exhausted, whichever comes first.

Households who heat with propane and wood burning stoves are also eligible for assistance.

# TO APPLY FOR THE HEAT PROGRAM

**Online** : You can apply online at <https://jobs.utah.gov/mycase/web/heat/app>

What you need to apply :

- Utility account numbers for gas, electricity, or propane.
- Social security numbers for everyone in the household
- Income for all adults in the household - month prior to your application date
- Proof of payment to Medical expenses paid out of pocket for the month prior to your application date
- Additional information may be requested at the time the application is processed

# What is Weatherization?

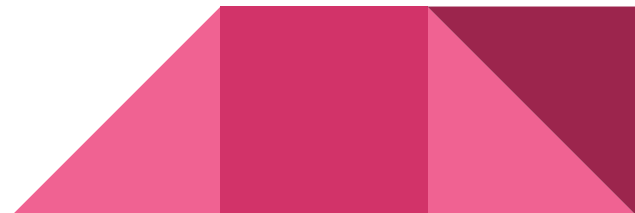


The Weatherization Assistance Program is funded by the U.S. Department of Energy, U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Rocky Mountain Power(rebates) and Dominion Energy.

Weatherization is the use of building science principles and energy modeling to identify improvements to the thermal and pressure boundary of a home. Using this data in a energy modeling program provided by the federal government to produce a scope of work. Work is determined by calculated savings to investment ratio and a preset budget for each home. (ACPU is \$8,009.00)

# What can the program do?

- Perform an energy audit to identify cost effective energy improvements
- Potentially install insulation in walls, attics and around electrical outlets
- Occasionally replace specific individual exterior doors and/or windows
- Check for Carbon Monoxide and overall air quality
- Perform a furnace safety/efficiency testing and tuning up as necessary
- Perform water heater safety test.
- Occasionally replace qualifying heating systems



## What won't the program do?

- Remodel or renovate the home
- Install storm doors or storm windows
- Paint interior or exterior
- Remove biohazards (biological, asbestos, lead)
- Replace entire roofs
- Replace all windows and/or doors

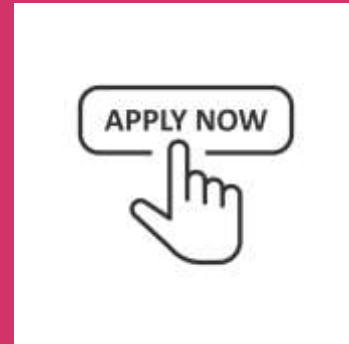

- Copy of most recent utility bills-
- Optional Map-

## ★ Heating System Repair or Replacement

- HEAT Certified
- Budget is not spent

## ★ Water Heater Replacement

- HEAT Certified
- Target Client (Children 5 and under, Disabled and/or Elderly 60+)
- Water heater replacement only if beyond simple repair

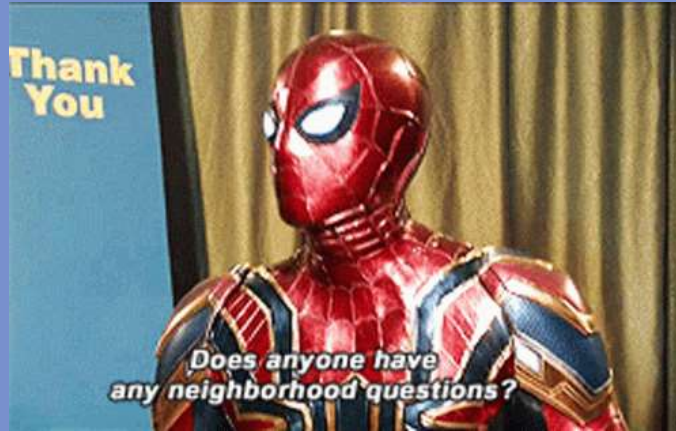
## ★ Cooling System Repair or Replacement

- HEAT Certified
- Target Client (Children 5 and under, Disabled and/or Elderly 60+)

We usually replace equipment “like for like” or “most equitable”
