SUMMARY

This amendment increases funding by \$500.00 and updates Attachment A, effective February 1, 2025, removing language that conflicts with HB261 Equal Opportunity Initiatives.

The general purpose of this contract is to provide Disease Intervention Services and Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Testing to individuals within San Juan County.

These services aim to reduce and control the spread of STDs through (1) prompt and confidential investigations and (2) expanding and training the Disease Intervention Specialist (DIS) workforce (e.g., cross-training in COVID-19, HIV, STDs, and other infectious diseases; conduct disease investigations including, case investigation, contact tracing, linkage to treatment, referrals, case management, and outbreak response).

The funding amount will be increased by \$500.00 in federally reimbursed funding with no local obligation for activities between February 1, 2025, through December 31, 2099 (76 years).
