Jens Nielson, Deputy County Attorney, presented the policies and procedures for the commission to review and discuss. The commissioners discussed adding an electronic meeting

policy, clarification of the commission roles for the Board of Equalization, Board of Canvass, Re-Development Agency (RDA) and administrative meetings which are outside of regularly scheduled commission meetings. There was discussion regarding the Open Meetings Act (OPMA) and who was the official representative of the commission and who was there for information gathering purposes.

The commission talked about potential disruptions by the public and how the policy & procedures would direct them to act.

2. San Juan County Local Homeless Council Services. Rosa Vargas, Executive Assistant

Rosa Vargas, County Homeless Coordinator, presented an update on the local homeless prevention council services program for the commission to review and discuss. The program is intended to prevent homelessness by keeping applicants housed, they provide aid in the form of rental deposits, rent assistance, and utility bill payments.

Rosa stated that a new part-time employee has been hired to lead the program, she will interview clients and develop marketing ads for the radio and the newspapers. There have been 42 applications received so far: 31 applied online, 11 applied in person.
