A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SANTAQUIN CITY, UTAH, DECLARING THE MONTH OF MAY EACH YEAR AS “SGT. BILL HOOSER MEMORIAL MONTH” IN HONOR OF HIS LIFE, SERVICE, AND SACRIFICE

WHEREAS, Santaquin City (“City”) is a fourth-class political subdivision of the State of Utah and has a responsibility to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Bill Hooser was a valued and respected member of the Santaquin community and was a Sergeant with the Santaquin City Police Department who faithfully served with honor, integrity, and dedication; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Bill Hooser gave his life in the line of duty on May 5, 2024, making the ultimate sacrifice while in service to others and to the community he loved; and

WHEREAS, his courage, selflessness, and unwavering commitment to public service exemplify the highest ideals of civic duty and community stewardship; and

WHEREAS, the loss of Sgt. Bill Hooser is deeply felt by his family, colleagues, and the residents of Santaquin City, and his legacy continues to inspire all who knew him and those who continue to benefit from his service; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the Santaquin City Council to formally recognize and honor the life, service, and sacrifice of Sgt. Bill Hooser and to designate a time for community remembrance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Santaquin City, Utah:

Section 1. Declaration. The month of May each year is hereby declared as “Sgt. Bill Hooser Memorial Month” in Santaquin City.

Section 2. Recognition. The City encourages residents, community organizations, and local institutions to honor the life, service, and sacrifice of Sgt. Bill Hooser throughout the month.

Section 3. Remembrance. Citizens are encouraged to reflect upon and uphold the values demonstrated by Sgt. Bill Hooser, including courage, service, and devotion to community.
