We felt being across from an elementary school would provide a level of safety that we wouldn't be able to find elsewhere, however so far we have been sorely disappointed.

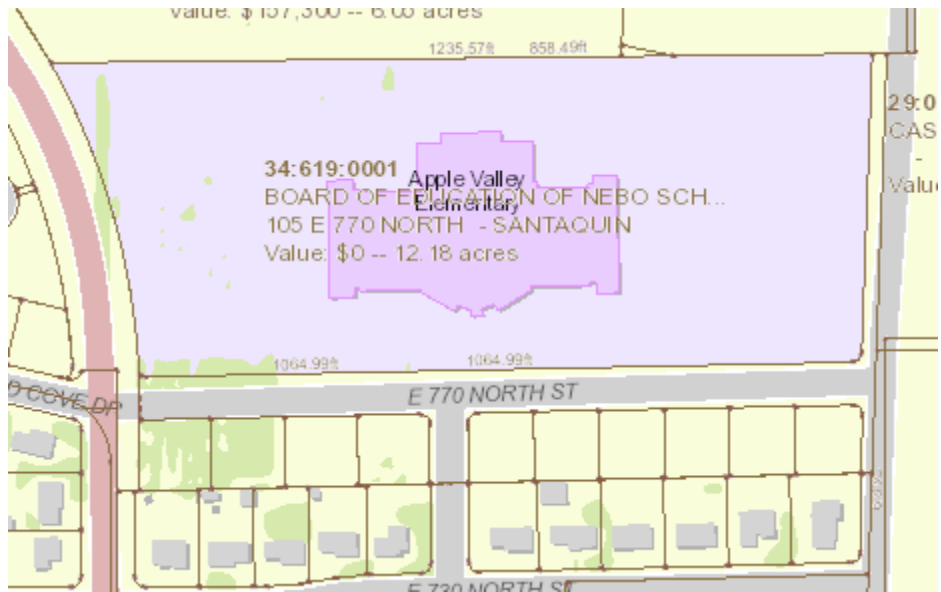

Living across from the elementary school, we were prepared for this, however we were not prepared for the utter disregard to the implied 25mph speed limit. On a regular basis, cars speed excessively down our road, putting our children, our neighbors children, and the numerous children that flock to the elementary school after hours to play, at risk. This is especially problematic because there absolutely no speed limit signs, children at play sign, or any indication at all that drivers need to be cautious and aware of the children in the area.

As the mother of an autistic child, as well as three other children, I am doing my best to teach my kids proper road safety as they play with their friends outside. However, we (as a neighborhood) feel Santaquin City needs to do their part to ensure the safety of our children.

For this reason, we are asking that it be considered to put a speed bump, a stop sign, a children at play sign, or at the very least, a 25 mph sign on the street 770 N near Apple Valley Elementary.
