### BROWNFIELD? WHAT IS A

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) defines a brownfield as:

- redevelopment, or reuse of which may be complicated by the *presence or* substance, pollutant, or contaminant" *potential presence* of a hazardous "real property, the expansion
- brownfields in the US\* \*There are an estimated 450,000
