

**ORDINANCE NO: 890**

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE INCOME NECESSARY TO FINANCE THE 2026-2027  
FISCAL BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF SARATOGA,  
CARBON COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF SARATOGA,  
CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING**

Section 1: The amount of general revenue necessary to be raised for municipal purposes and to meet current expenditures of the Town of Saratoga, Carbon County, State of Wyoming during the Fiscal Year July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027 is hereby fixed at the suitable levy on the Town of Saratoga assessed valuation.

Section 2: That for the General Fund of said Town, there be levied a suitable tax of eight (8) mills on all real and personal property in the Town of Saratoga, subject to taxation for the purpose of raising the sum of a portion of the appropriation which includes other anticipated revenue charges and income for operation and maintenance of the General Fund.
