Pool: The Sedgwick Community Pool will be closing for the season on Saturday, August 9th with the pooch plunge taking place on Sunday, August 10th. We would like to thank everyone who attended this year and thank those members of our team who kept the pool up and running this season!

PW & Utilities: As the school year approaches, we will be losing our seasonal help and moving back down to the four full-time employees in public works. We want to thank Wyatt Requa and Koen Werner for another year's help during the summer.

You may have noticed that two trees were removed from the city park this past week. The city contracted with Arbor Masters to remove two dead trees near the gazebo. They will be coming back in the next couple of weeks to grind out the stumps and make the area level again.

The north rotor at the sewer plant has been repaired and is back in operating condition. Earlier in the year, the bearing went out on the rotor causing it to be out of order. Further investigation by JCI concluded that the shaft that rotates the contraption was out of balance which was the cause of the bearing failing.

Fire/EMS Station: Staff met with the BG team and Ranson Financial last week to review the 90% Construction Drawing Progress. The schedule below will take us through the remainder of the year for the project.
