Alternative Technologies Grant: I am pleased to announce that our co-application with the City of Halstead was selected as a project to be funded. This funding will provide equipment to bring Ai analysis of the roadways, line marking, and street signs to Sedgwick to better assist us in making recommendations for our annual street improvements.

Downtown Corridor: You may notice that the awnings have come down at the building next to the library. Thanks to work by our public works & utilities department along with the collaborative efforts of the building owner, work to revitalize the façade of the building has taken place. When the weather cooperates, the building will receive brand new glass to replace the broken and missing pieces. Furthering efforts, we have contracted with a cleaning company to soft wash the building frontage to remove the algae growth and other debris.
