**SUBJECT:** Firework Sales & Detonation Times

**Recommendation:** Approve the sales and detonation times as presented.

<u>Background:</u> The fourth of July is on a Thursday this year. Historically, the city has allowed for detonation times from 10am - 10pm on Monday through Saturday and from noon - 10pm on Sundays. The exception being on the  $3^{rd}$  &  $4^{th}$  detonation times were extended to midnight.

Newton adopted a new time frame this year allowing for detonations to occur June  $28^{th}$ ,  $29^{th}$ , and July  $3^{rd}$  from 10am - 10pm and on July  $4^{th}$  from 7am - 10pm.

Last year, neighboring cities in Harvey County allowed for the following times:

- Halstead: Sunday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>: 8am Midnight
- Hesston: Saturday, July 1<sup>st</sup> Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>: 8am 10pm

Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>: 8am – Midnight

- Unincorporated Harvey County: Saturday, July 1<sup>st</sup> – Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>: 8am – Midnight

## Staff Proposal:

Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup>: 10am – 10pm Sunday, June 30<sup>th</sup>: Noon – 10pm Monday, July 1<sup>st</sup>: 10am – 10pm Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>: 10am – 10pm

Wednesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> – Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>: 10am - Midnight

<u>Financial Considerations:</u> The city has consistently had three fireworks vendors in years past and anticipates that to remain true this year. Aside from fees collected from those vendors, there are minimal financial aspects to consider.

**Recommendations/Actions:** It is recommended that the City Council approve the sales and detonation times as presented.
