

**CITY OF SHEBOYGAN
RESOLUTION 100-26-27**

SEPTEMBER 8, 2026.

A RESOLUTION directing city staff to terminate the City's agreement with Flock Group Inc., DBA Flock Safety, and to not appropriate funds in the 2027 budget for Flock Safety services.

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan Common Council authorized the Police Chief to execute a "Master Services Agreement" with Flock Safety on December 18, 2023, under Res. No. 115-23-24 and R.C. No. 161-23-24, to provide 15 Flock Safety Falcon automated license plate reader (ALPR) cameras; and

WHEREAS, Flock Safety's "Master Services Agreement" dictates that Flock Safety "does not own and shall not sell Customer Data" or "Anonymized Data", and that the retention period for Customer Data is 30 days; and

WHEREAS, in late July 2026 the Sheboygan Police Department was made aware of an email from Flock Safety's account executive, dated March 24, 2026, offering to sell the Sheboygan Department of Public Works anonymized data for traffic volume, vehicle types and speed data, offering up to five years of data utilizing the existing 15 cameras already deployed in the City of Sheboygan under the "Master Services Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan Police Department was not aware of and did not consent to the sale of anonymized or other data outside of the terms of the "Master Services Agreement" and believes that such conduct on the part of Flock Safety constitutes a breach of the terms of the "Master Services Agreement," specifically Section 4: "DATA USE AND LICENSING"; and

WHEREAS, Provision 11.16 of the Master Services Agreement and Wis. Stat. s. 65.06 allows the City to terminate upon thirty days' written notice should a future Common Council decide not to appropriate adequate funding to support Flock safety services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Common Council directs City staff to provide Flock Group Inc., DBA Flock Safety a written notice to terminate the Master Services Agreement effective December 31, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Common Council directs City staff to maintain coverings on existing Flock traffic cameras until such time as Flock Group Inc. removes the hardware and devices from the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Common Council directs the Finance Director and City Administrator to remove any appropriations for Flock safety services from the 2027 budget.
