# **BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:**

The Sheboygan Police Department included funding in the 2022 Public Safety Building Improvements Budget for the remediation of the outdoor earthen berm style practice shooting range located at the Wastewater Treatment Plant and operated by the Sheboygan Police Dept.

### **STAFF COMMENTS:**

The Sheboygan Police Department has utilized the range for many years in the interest of Police Officer firearm training and qualification. The earthen berm backstop however requires remediation to remove a heavy concentration of lead bullet fragments. This work involves the removal of soil which is processed through equipment to remove the bullet fragments and ultimately returned to the berm. The bullet fragments are then recycled through a licensed lead reclamation facility. Additionally, as the berm is located outside, some vegetation removal will be required preceding the reclamation of the bullet fragments. This work is being done utilizing a local landscape firm and with the assistance of the city Forestry crews. The Reclamation work was put to competitive bid and the bid submitted by Metals Treatment Technologies has been found to meet all of the requirements.

## **ACTION REQUESTED:**

A Motion to recommend that the Council approve Resolution #59-22-23 to authorize the appropriate City Officials to enter into contract with Metals Treatment Technologies (MT2) for the remediation of the earthen Berm outdoor shooting range to be completed at cost of \$32,000.00
