## BY LICENSING, HEARINGS, AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE.

## AUGUST 5, 2024.

Your committee met on July 25, 2024 to consider a request by David A. Repinski, agent for Dave's Who's Inn, holder of Alcohol Beverage No. 1089, to modify voluntary conditions imposed in lieu of a hearing on revocation of said license.

After hearing from representatives of the license holder and of the Sheboygan Police Department, your committee recommends that the common council accept an amendment of the voluntary conditions agreed to by the license holder in order to avoid a hearing on revocation as follows:

- 1. The voluntary condition prohibiting underage persons on the premises except for pinsetters who are actually working and being paid may be removed. Restrictions on underage persons shall be as provided in state statute, with no additional restrictions.
- 2. The voluntary condition requiring prohibition of all weapons and the use of a metal detector on all patrons entering the premises may be amended to provide prohibition of all weapons and the use of a metal detector on all patrons entering the premises between 10 p.m. and closing time on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.
- 3. All other voluntary conditions will remain in place for the remainder of the license year. Any decision on extending one or more such conditions shall be reviewed by the Licensing, Hearings, and Public Safety Committee at the time the license holder applies for renewal of said license.
- 4. As a result of this action, the conditions voluntarily agreed to by the parties for the current license year shall be as follows:
  - Cooperation with the police.
  - Continued membership in the Tavern Safety Coalition and following its guidelines.
  - Prohibition of all weapons and use of a metal detector on all patrons entering the premises between 10 p.m. and closing time on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.
  - Use of a scanner that also takes photos of all patrons entering the premises.

- Ensuring all video cameras (inside and outside) are operational and recording when open for business.
- No serving intoxicated people.
- Denial of entry to any patrons who are visibly intoxicated.
- Removal of all patrons who are visibly intoxicated from the premises.
- Prohibiting staff from drinking while working.
- Communication of these expectations to all staff.

Failure to abide by these conditions would result in the reinstatement of license revocation procedures pursuant to Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
