RESOLUTION 97-26-27**

A RESOLUTION authorizing the appropriate City officials to execute a joint agreement with Allyson Brunette Consulting and CP2 Consulting.

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan has experienced considerable organizational change over the past several years, and there is a clear need to reset direction, rebuild internal culture, strengthen trust with the community, and establish priorities for the years ahead; and

WHEREAS, the City recommends engaging Allyson Brunette Consulting and CP2 Consulting to guide the City through a comprehensive strategic planning effort that includes developing organizational values, a mission and vision, and strategic priorities for 2028–2032; and

WHEREAS, the consultants' proposal includes interviews with elected officials and staff, internal and external stakeholders, community surveys, public engagement activities, strategic planning workshops, development of project plans and RACI charts, and preparation of a final strategic plan for adoption by the Common Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Common Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to enter into an agreement, as approved by the City Attorney, with Allyson Brunette Consulting and CP2 Consulting for the provision of strategic planning services as outlined in the proposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Finance Director is authorized to amend the City's budget as allowed by the City Financial Handbook to utilize contingency, Administration salary savings and other department budget lines to contribute toward the cost of this agreement.
