Dear Mr. Reinhardt:

The Board of License Examiners met on Tuesday, December 3, 2024 to discuss a complaint received concerning your lack of fulfillment of a contract for work at 2002 N 10th St in Sheboygan.

The Board discussed the complaint with the home owner and feel the complaint has merit for:

- 1) Abandonment of contract without legal excuse
- 2) Fraudulent departure from or disregard of plans or specifications in any material respect, without the consent of the owner or the owner's duly authorized representative, or the doing of any willful, fraudulent act by the licensee as a contractor in consequence of which another is substantially injured (materials used were not agreed to by owner).
- Failure to fulfill contractual obligations through inability to pay all creditors for materials furnished, or work or services performed under the contract (you didn't complete the project).
- 4) Work does not meet building code.

If you desire to respond to this complaint, please write a letter to the Board within 30 days stating your reasons why this complaint should not be recorded against you.
