A RESOLUTION authorizing the appropriate City staff to adjust the Fleet Mechanic position within the City's compensation table.

WHEREAS, the Employee Policy Handbook authorizes a position reclassification when substantial (at least 51%) changes to duties occur, upon approval of the department head, human resources director, and city administrator, and in consultation with the City's compensation and classification consultant; and

WHEREAS, most reclassifications are implemented within an annual budget except that reclassifications triggered by position vacancy may be implemented throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department conducted a comprehensive review of the Fleet Mechanic Uplifter position, which included a comparative review of Fleet Mechanic positions from other City divisions; and

WHEREAS, based on that review, the Police Chief submitted a request to the human resources director to reclassify the Fleet Mechanic Uplifter position from grade 11 to grade 12; and

WHEREAS, the former human resources director reviewed and agreed with the Police Chief's recommendations and approved reclassification effective August 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, given the deviation from policy, the budgetary impact of such a reclassification, and that this reclassification is not implemented as part of annual budget approval process, City staff believes it is appropriate to secure Common Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Fleet Mechanic Uplifter position is reclassified from grade 11 to grade 12 effective August 17, 2025.
