A RESOLUTION adopting the City's 2026-2028 Title VI Program Manual.

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI) is a federal law which provides that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 makes clear that a local governmental entity that accepts Federal financial assistance may not engage in the type of discrimination prohibited by Title VI. Title VI applies to recipients and sub-recipients of Federal financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of its services as protected by Title VI in Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Circular 4702.1.B, among other federal departments providing funding to subrecipients, and other nondiscrimination statutes and directives, on the basis of such characteristics as age, ancestry, gender, marital status, disability, and others.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City hereby adopts the 2026-2028 Title VI Program Manual and authorizes the appropriate City officials to take such steps as are necessary to update the City's website to reflect the information contained within the Program Manual.
